#### INDICTMENT

18 U.S.C. § 1030(a)(3) [Unlawfully Accessing Non-Public Government Computer]; 18 U.S.C. § 1030(a)(5)(A)(i) [Intentional Damage To Protected Computer]

The Grand Jury charges:

#### INTRODUCTORY ALLEGATIONS

At all times pertinent to this Indictment:

- 1. The Defense Information Systems Agency ("DISA") was an agency of the United States Department of Defense. DISA was responsible, among other things, for maintaining particular web-based computers used for computer-based training for United States Air Force and other military personnel. These DISA computers were for the exclusive use of the United States government, and were located in Denver, Colorado.
- 2. The "World of Hell" was a group comprised of persons who assisted each other with, and communicated regarding intrusions they made into computer systems owned by the United

States government, state and local governments, foreign governments, and businesses and corporations in the United States and elsewhere.

- 3. Defendant RAFAEL NUNEZ-APONTE was a member of World of Hell, and used the hacker name "RaFa" in connection with his computer intrusions and dealings with other World of Hell members.
- 4. These Introductory Allegations are incorporated by this reference into each count of this indictment as though set forth fully therein.

# COUNT ONE 18 U.S.C. § 1030(a)(3) [Unlawfully Accessing Non-Public Government Computer]

- 5. On or about June 10, 2001, in Denver, Colorado, within the State and District of Colorado, the defendant, RAFAEL NUNEZ-APONTE, who was not authorized to access any non-public computer of the Department of Defense, Defense Information Systems Agency, accessed computers of that agency, which computers were exclusively for the use of the United States government, and the United States government's use of those DISA computers was affected by the defendant's conduct. In particular, defendant RAFAEL NUNEZ-APONTE:
  - (a) perpetrated a web-page defacement on the DISA web-based computers by altering the web-page to read "WoH is Back. . . and kiss my ass cause I just 0wn3d yours! 
    America's Air Force Department of Defense computer system 0wn3d by [RaFa] 
    woh@world-of-hell.com http://www.world-of-hell.com;"
  - (b) deleted logging information from the DISA computers; and
- (c) sent transmissions to the DISA computers that rendered them inoperable and inaccessible to Air Force personnel. The foregoing was in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1030(a)(3).

### **COUNT TWO** 18 U.S.C. § 1030(a)(5)(A)(i) [Intentional Damage To A Protected Computer]

6. On or about June 10, 2001, in Denver, Colorado, within the State and District of Colorado, the defendant, RAFAEL NUNEZ-APONTE, knowingly caused the transmission of a program, information, code or command to a protected computer that was exclusively for the use of the Department of Defense, Defense Information Systems Agency, and as a result of such conduct, intentionally and without authorization caused damage resulting in a loss to DISA over \$5,000. In particular, defendant RAFAEL NUNEZ-APONTE: (a) perpetrated a web-page defacement on DISA web-based computers by altering the DISA web-page to read "WoH is Back. . . and kiss my ass cause I just 0wn3d yours! - America's Air Force Department of Defense computer system 0wn3d by [RaFa] - woh@world-of-hell.com - http://www.world-ofhell.com; and (b) deleted logging information from the DISA computers, and thereby intentionally impaired the availability of data, resulting in losses to DISA in an amount which aggregated \$5,000 or more during the period including June 2001. The foregoing was in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1030(a)(5)(A)(i).
